## WHY ATTENDANCE MATTERS

There are 194 school days in a given year. Missing a "few" might not seem like a big deal, but "a day here and a day there" can add up to a substantial amount of opportunity lost.

| 1 day every 2 weeks | 20 days per year | 4 weeks per year | Nearly $11 / 2$ years of school |
| 1 day per week | 40 days per year | 8 weeks per year | Over $21 / 2$ years of school |
| 2 days per week | 80 days per year | 16 weeks per year | Over 5 years of school |
| 3 days per week | 120 days per year | 24 weeks per year | Almost 8 years of school |
